Re: Wash test comparison results

Mr. Still,

Puget Sound Laundry Service has completed your requested wash test on 9 different garments provided to us by your company.

Test Garments

Garments for the test included 3 garments from vendor "A", 3 garments from vendor "B", and 3 garments from jstill llc. All 6 competitor garments were from reputable competitors in the medical garment industry. While the garments were not all the same color, they were approximately the same size.

Wash Test Protocol

The wash test was done in accordance with CWT and NAILM best practices with the entire process being overseen by a CLLM certified manager with 13 years of laundry experience.

The test included washing in 6 different wash cycles and each wash cycle was run multiple times. Wash cycles included a bleach wash, heavy soil wash and a hydrogen peroxide wash. All 9 test garments were washed together to assure the same wash formula and wash time on each garment.

Results

Based on these wash test results, we conclude that the jstill llc products were superior to the competitors based on fabric breakdown and color fading.

Color Fading

Vendor "A" product results: linen broke down where you could "see through" the robe. jstill garment: no color breakdown.

Fabric Breakdown

Vendor "B" results: color fading and wear around the edges was noticeable.
jstill results: no fabric breakdown.
